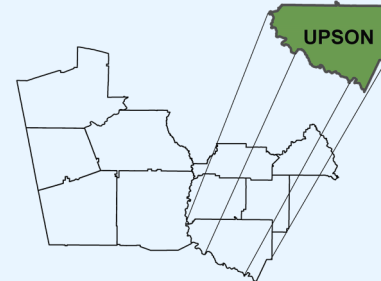


UPSON COUNTY FY'22 FACTS

- ◆ \$524,584 dollars in local dues leveraged into \$12,858,205

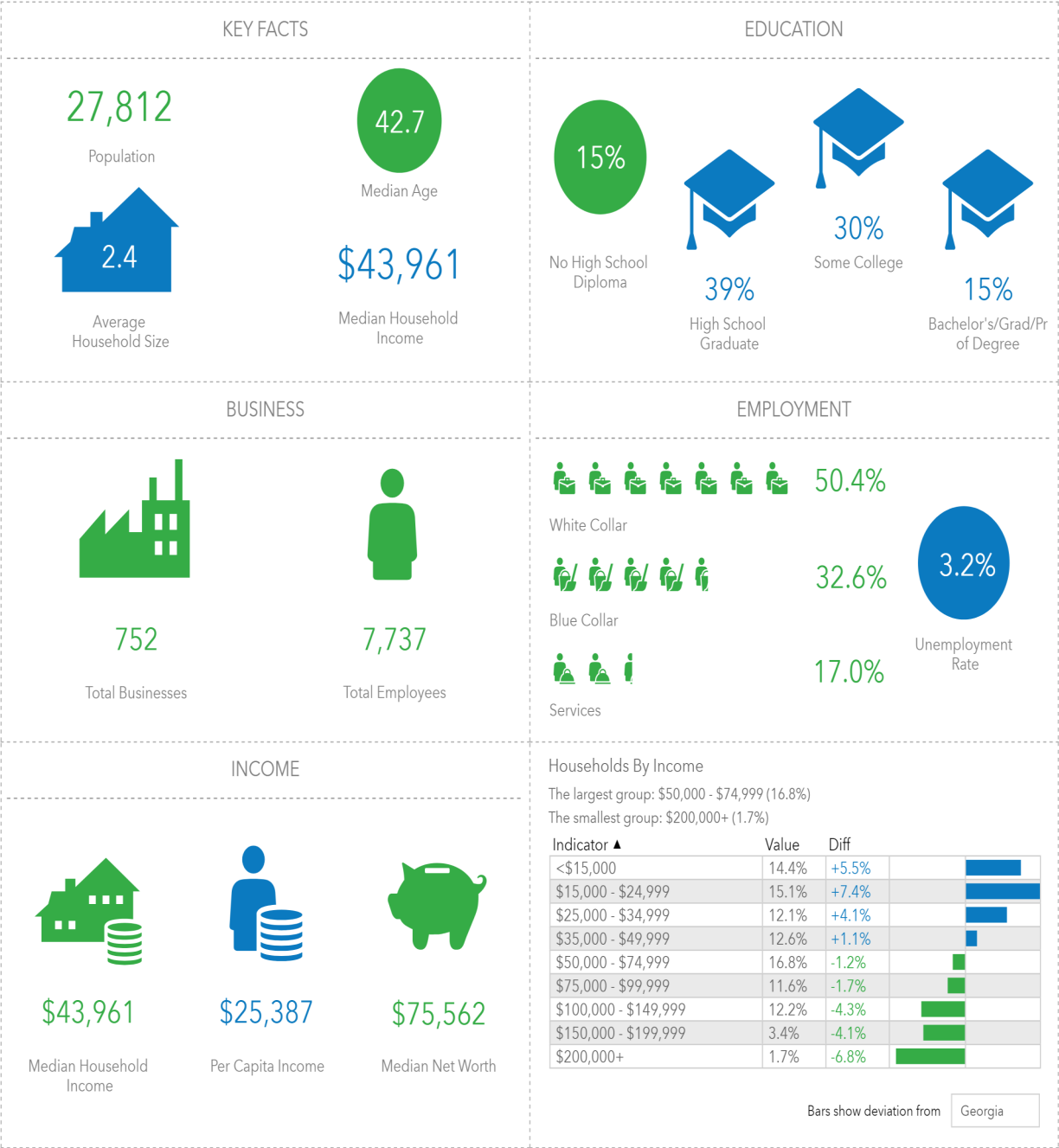
