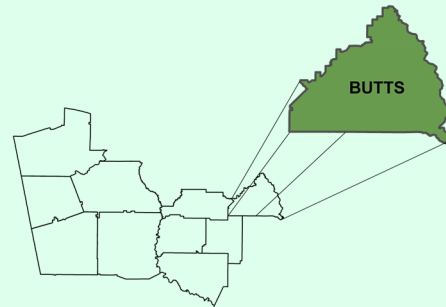


## BUTTS COUNTY FY'18 FACTS

### AGING SERVICES

- ◆ meals provided: 16,796
- ◆ Medicare counseling (# of people served): 900
- ◆ in-home services: 148 hours/\$2,871.20
- ◆ calls coming in for services: 289

### TRANSIT SERVICES

- ◆ number of vehicles: 1
- ◆ total number of trips: 5,505
- ◆ total cost: \$77,642.75
- ◆ county pays: \$2,800.00
- ◆ purposes:

### **THREE RIVERS REGIONAL COMMISSION FY'18 REGIONAL FACTS**

- ◆ *\$500,000 dollars in local dues leveraged into \$12,000,000 in services*
- ◆ *280,000 in-home and community meals served*
- ◆ *215,000 rural transportation trips provided*
- ◆ *400 youth and 900 adults served*

The Three Rivers Regional Commission is served by a Regional Council that includes three (3) members from each of the ten (10) counties in the region. The current members of the Council includes the County Commission Chair or his/her designee, a mayoral representative from the cities in that county, and a non-public member. There are also five state appointees. Only one of those positions is currently filled.

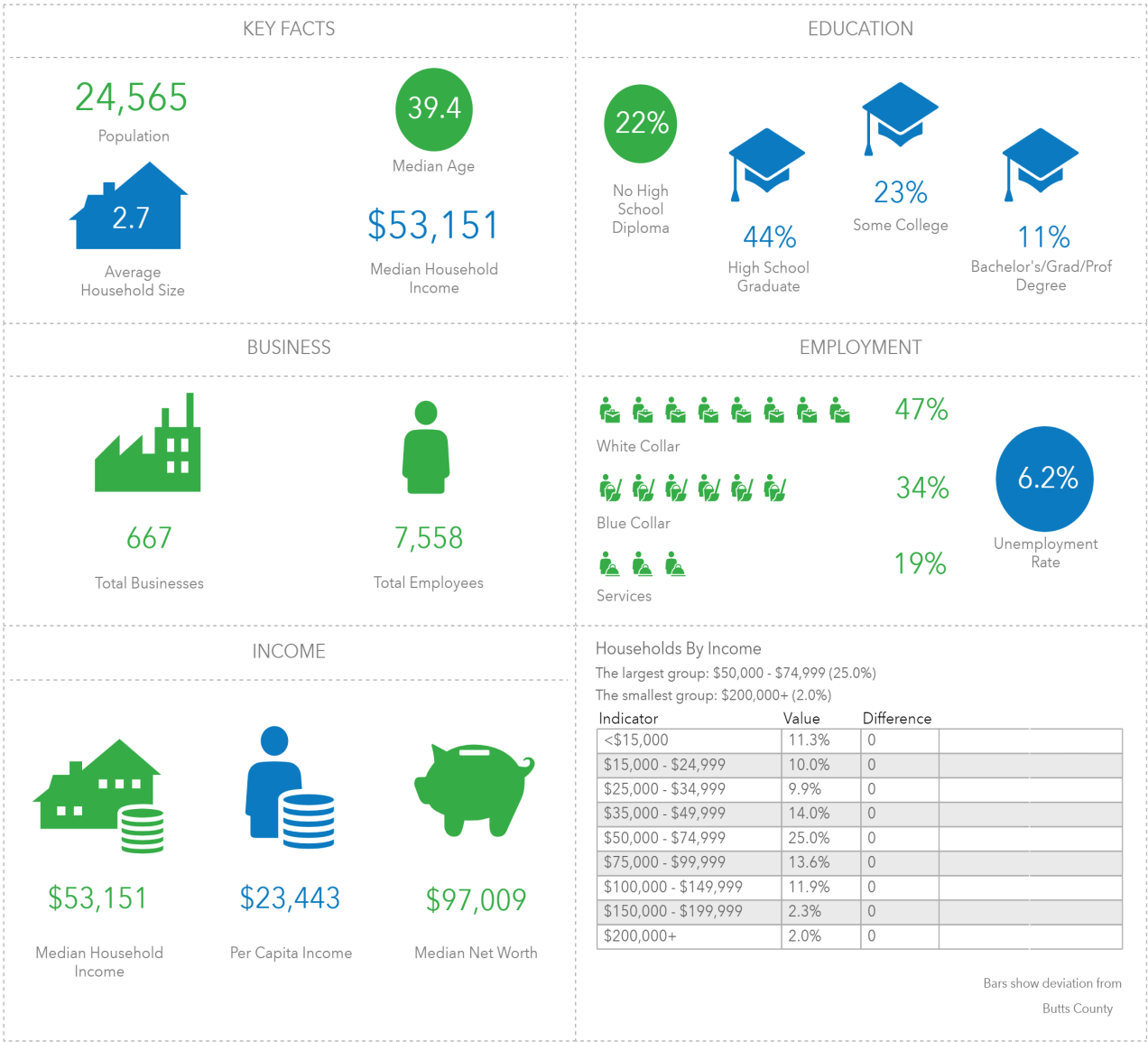
Council members from Butts County are as follows:
