


THREE RIVERS REGIONAL COMMISSION FY'18 REGIONAL FACTS

- ♦ \$500,000 dollars in local dues leveraged into \$12,000,000 in services
- ♦ 280,000 in-home and community meals served
- 215,000 rural transportation trips provided
- 400 youth and 900 adults served

The Three Rivers Regional Commission is served by a Regional Council that includes three (3) members from each of the ten (10) counties in the region. The current members of the Council includes the County Commission Chair or his/her designee, a mayoral representative from the cities in that county, and a non-public member. There are also five state appointees. Only one of those positions is currently filled.
